Petitioner filed this writ petition being aggrieved by the action of the respondents in not affording her Child Care Leave.

It is submitted that the petitioner's son is suffering from depression, however, Child Care Leave, was wrongly denied to her.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has circulated a copy of order dated 21.10.2021, passed by the Director Secondary Education, Haryana, Panchkula, whereby Child Care Leave of 162 days has been afforded to the petitioner subject to fulfillment of provision of Rule 46 of Haryana Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 2016.

In view of order dated 21.10.2021 passed by the Director Secondary Education, Haryana, Panchkula, present writ petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly. Needless to say, petitioner is at liberty to seek extension of the Child Care Leave, if required, which be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law.
