This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 27.07.2019, under Sections 363, 366-A, 511, 376 of IPC, 1860 and Section 6 of POCSO, Act registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Sector-5, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said FIR and the petitioner is in custody since 28.07.2019. He further submits that there are total 23 witnesses cited, out of which only 7 witnesses have been examined so far. Since the trial is likely to take long time so he may be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposes the grant of bail on the ground that there are serious allegations levelled against the petitioner.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the trial be expedited.

Heard.

In view of the above, without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
