The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.108 dated 10.10.2020 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Balianwali.

Notice of motion was issued on 25.11.2020, on the premise that the petitioner had never been paid any money rather he himself is a victim. The complaint was against other co-accused but the amount was paid to the co-accused in the house of the petitioner. Thereafter, vide order dated 07.01.2021, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation along with interim direction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has finally joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer in pursuance of order

dated 07.01.2021.

This fact has been admitted by Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 07.01.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
