The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents for counting the work charged service period i.e. from 15.01.1977 to 04.06.1986 alongwith regular service from 05.06.1986 to 31.05.2004 for the grant of pensionary benefits alongwith interest @ 18% per annum, for which, representation dated 04.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) has also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representation dated 04.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
