These petitions have been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioners in case FIR No. 57, dated 31.05.2021, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 304/34 of the IPC (with Section 201 of the IPC having been added later).

A reply has been filed by learned State counsel (in CRM-M-43109-2021), dated 13.12.2021, which is ordered to be taken on record.

He submits upon query of this court that the report under the provisions of Section 173 (2) of the Cr.P.C. has been submitted to the trial court, with no prosecution witness having been examined so far.

Looking at the nature of offences alleged to have been committed even as per the affidavit of the DSP, with both the petitioners stated to have been in custody for the past 06 months, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petitions are allowed. The petitioners shall be admitted to bail upon their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
