Prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to grant compensation to the petitioners on account of death of husband of petitioner no.1 and father of petitioners no.2 to 4, in an accident caused due to a bull/stray cattle coming in front of the motorcycle of Parahlad Singh.

It is submitted that the compensation has not been granted to the petitioners till today, despite serving legal notice dated 19.10.2020, Annexure P-4 and 08.04.2021, Annexure P-5, upon the respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rohit Arya, DAG., Haryana, at the asking of the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Advance copy of writ petition stand supplied.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts the prayer for a decision of legal notice dated 08.04.2021, Annexure P-5 served by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents does not raise any serious

objection to the restricted prayer.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide legal notice dated 08.04.2021, Annexure P-5, filed by the petitioners by passing a speaking order, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners. In case, petitioners are found entitled to any amount as claimed, the same be released within six weeks thereafter.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
