HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one Smt. Radha, who was being taken care of by the petitioner, gifted a property to him to the exclusion of her children and now, the children of Smt. Radha, being perturbed over the said action, are trying to encroach upon the said property though, the civil litigation in respect to the said gift deed is already pending consideration before the competent Court of law. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the children of Smt. Radha trespassed on to the property, which the petitioner claims to be having possession of, hence petitioner filed a complaint before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana on 02.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) but no action has been taken by the police so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent

No.2 to decide the representation dated 02.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Bhavna Gupta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection for deciding the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 02.04.2021 (Annexure P-5), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 02.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that the order on the representation is passed by respondent No.2 after associating all the persons who will be affected including respondents No.2 to 6, who have been arrayed as party in the present petition.
