Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, pending trial in case FIR No.156 dated 25.08.2020, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 IPC, 1860 and Section 66-D Information and Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station, Cyber Crime, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

On 01.09.2021, the following order was passed:-

Learned counsel for the complainant has stated that the concession of interim regular bail granted to the petitioner by the trial court ended yesterday, i.e., 31.08.2021, however, the accused is yet to surrender.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for time to seek instructions.

On his request, adjourned to 23.11.2021.”

Today, learned State counsel has stated that indeed the petitioner has not surrendered despite the period of interim bail granted to him is over.

Faced with this stand of the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

The prayer is accepted.
