This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 43 dated 23.02.2021 registered under Sections 20 (b)(ii) (c) 27A and 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad District Fatehabad.

As per prosecution story, on 23.02.2021, Ram Niwas @ Kala and Dharamvir Singh were found in possession of 2 qtls, 1 kgs 450 gms of *ganja* in the Etios car. During the course of investigation, it came to fore that 50 kgs of *ganja* belonged to Dharamvir Singh, 50 kgs of *ganja* belonged to Kuldeep @ Figo, 50 kgs of *ganja* belonged to the petitioner and remaining 50 kgs of *ganja* belonged to co-accused Naveen @ Neetu. All the aforesaid four persons conspired to procure the

contraband from Andhra Pradesh. Co-accused Naveen @ Neetu, Kuldeep @ Figo and the petitioner were travelling in a Swift Dzire car belonging to Naveen @ Neetu, which was escorting the Etios car loaded with *ganja*. After reaching Hisar, Naveen @ Neetu along with Kuldeep @ Figo and the petitioner went to Bhuna from Hisar. Police apprehended the Etios car on the basis of material collected vis-a-vis the call details between Naveen @ Neetu and the other co-accused including the petitioner. Co-accused Naveen @ Neetu filed CRM-M No.13366 of 2021 for grant of anticipatory bail, which was dismissed by the co-ordinate bench vide order dated 28.05.2021 by passing a detailed order.

No exception can be made out in case of the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
