This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.74 dated 15.04.2021, under Sections 379-B, 411 & 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for almost seven months, since 01.05.2021.

[3]. After completion of the investigation, Challan against the petitioner has already been submitted and Charges have also been framed. As such, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in judicial custody for an indefinite period.
