Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.122 dated 24.08.2020 under Sections 148, 307, 323, 324, 336 and 452 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka, Punjab.

It is pertinent to mention here that on the last date of hearing, learned State counsel had informed the Court that during the course of investigation, offences under Sections 148, 307, 336 and 452 IPC read

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with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act have been deleted from the array of offences, whereas offence under Section 326 IPC read with Section 34 IPC has been added in the instant case FIR.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Ranjeet Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 19.11.2020, petitioner has already joined investigation and got recovered spade (*kahi*) and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 19.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
