Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.2 dated 02.01.2021 under Sections 379-A, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa; earlier one was dismissed as withdrawn.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that new ground for filing this second petition is that the petitioners have undergone 09 months of custody; investigation is complete and challan stands presented. It is further submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of one Bittu Sachdeva, when she was going to her shop on foot, two persons came on a

motorcycle and snatched a plastic envelope, Rs.5900/- and two mobile phones. It is also submitted that the petitioners are first offenders and are not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial will take some time, as out of total 09 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 25.10.2021 in the Court today and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid submissions, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing their bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
