Through this petition filed under Section 24 CPC, the petitioner (wife) prays for transfer of the divorce petition (Pushpinder Kaur Vs. Sandeep Singh Wilkhu) pending before Family Court, Jalandhar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Mohali. It is pleaded that she is taking care of a minor child who is barely 5 years old. It is further pleaded that she was turned out of the matrimonial home in January, 2015. Now, at present, she being financially dependent on her parents is residing with them at Mohali. The distance between Jalandhar and Mohali is around 150 kms.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to transfer case No.DMC/1002/2019, pending in the Family Court, Jalandhar, to Mohali. Accordingly, the application is allowed. The transferor Court is requested to remit the file of the case to the transferee Court. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 31.03.2021.
