The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation from Police Station Kosli to Crime Branch, Rewari, so as to have fair investigation in FIR No.231 dated 06.08.2019 registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing, no one was present on his behalf.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mohinder Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rewari, District Rewari, has already been filed on behalf of the respondents. In para 6 of preliminary submissions, it has been stated as under:-

“6. That the present petition has been rendered as

infructuous in wake of the fact of that final report dated 21.12.2020 has already been filed on 5.1.21 in Court and no investigation is pending in the matter, so as to warrant invoking of its extra jurisdiction by this Hon'ble Court in ordering of the transfer of the investigation as prayed for and thus this being so the present petition is liable to be dismissed being the devoid of being any merits.”

As per the reply, reproduced above, the police has already completed investigation and final report was prepared on 21.12.2020 and the same has been filed in the court on 05.01.2021.

In view of above since the police has already conducted investigation and final report has been filed in the Court, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner feels that his grievance is still not redressed, he would be at liberty to seek revival of present petition within one month from today.
