By this order, two petitions, the details of which are mentioned above, are being disposed of as both these petitions arise out of the same incident.

In CRM No. M-42536 of 2021, the prayer is for quashing of

FIR No. 158, dated 02.11.2017, registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur, on the basis of compromise and the prayer in CRM No. M-43153 of 2021 is for quashing the cross version registered vide DDR No. 39, dated 03.11.2017, under Sections 324, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.
