This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

CRM-14559 of 2021.

Prayer in this application is for preponement of date hearing of CRM-M-38029 of 2020, which is listed for 31.08.2021.

Notice of the application.

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not raise any objection to preponement of hearing of CRM-M-38029 of 2020.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as well as specific stand taken by learned counsel for the respondent-State, hearing of CRM-M-38029 of 2020, is preponed from 31.08.2021 for today itself.

Application is accordingly disposed of.

CRM-M-38029 of 2020.

This is the petitioner's second bail application seeking bail pending trial in FIR No. 19 dated 06.03.2020, under Section 364 (120-B

added later on) IPC, Police Station Sadar Kotakpura, District Faridkot, the first application having been withdrawn.

It is specifically stated in the petition that petitioner has lost her minor child while she was in custody. CRM-495 of 2021 was filed by Mr. A.S.Brar, Advocate, who had filed this petition, seeking permission to withdraw his power of attorney on account of misrepresentation made by the petitioner to the effect that her minor child had expired due to which she was under depression. It is stated in the application that these instructions were given to the counsel by the petitioner through the jail authorities over telephone and due to this reason present petition was filed while taking a ground that petitioner's minor son has died in the interregnum. Earlier counsel was allowed to withdraw his power of attorney on 11.02.2021. Mr. Deepak Aggarwal, Advocate, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that averments regarding death of the petitioner's child are due to misinformation conveyed to the petitioner, who was in custody and further miscommunication with the earlier counsel. There was no intention of the petitioner to mislead the Court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to file afresh with correct/ better particulars.

Petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
