1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Report of the Warrant Officer dated 08.10.2021 as well as short reply by way of affidavit of Shri Harjit Singh, PPS, DSP, Dakha, District Ludhiana, on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 and 5 have been perused. As per the report of the Warrant Officer, the petitioner met him on 06.10.2021, at 10:40 pm at Verka Plant, Ferozepur Road, Ludhiana and informed him that he did not want raid to be carried out at any place as all the alleged detenues, who had been kidnapped had come back and, that in the circumstances, he wanted to withdraw the instant petition. Affidavit of Shri Harjit Singh, DSP, mentions that the alleged detenues mentioned in the petition are not wanted by the police of P.S. Sudhar in any case nor were arrested by the police in any case.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has instructions from the petitioner to withdraw the instant petition.
4. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
