The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the inaction of respondents in not revising the pension of the petitioner and writ of *mandamus* directing respondent No.4 to forward the pension papers of the petitioner to respondent No. 5 as has been sought by way of legal notice dated (Annexure P-17) served upon the respondent-authorities which is still pending.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the

directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice (Annexure P-17) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
