This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.167, dated 23.07.2021, registered under Sections 323, 498-A, 506, 447, 511, 34 of IPC at Police Station Division-4, District Patiala.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners herein prays for quashing of FIR by contending that the marriage between the parties i.e. respondent No.2 and the son of the petitioner No.1 took place in the year 2003 and, therefore, after a gap of 18 years, the instant FIR, *inter alia*, contending misappropriation of dowry articles would not be maintainable.

At this stage, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance through the medium of video conferencing and would submit

that the matter is still under investigation and challan has not yet been presented.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the instant petition and challenge afresh on the said cause of action should the challan be presented.
