Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.1 was married to Balwinder Singh, who unfortunately expired, and there is a dispute regarding his property between petitioner No.1 and private respondents No.4 to 7, who are her in-laws. He submits that a suit for injunction restraining them from transferring the property has been filed, wherein vide order dated 06.07.2020, Annexure P-1, the trial Court has restrained her brother-in-law (respondent No.4) from alienating 1/4th share out of the suit land. He submits that petitioner No.1 and her children (petitioners No.2 to 4) are facing threat from the private respondents and petitioner No.1 has been physically assaulted by them in July, 2021. He has

referred to the MLR dated 05.07.2021, Annexure P-2, to submit that petitioner No.1 has received injuries and despite submitting representation dated 08.07.2021 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga- respondent No.2, no action has been taken. Counsel submits that the petitioner No.1 will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation, Annexure P-3.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-3, and to take suitable action as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the order as well as the representation, Annexure P-3, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga – respondent No.2 in order to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
