The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and proceed against the private respondents in accordance with law who have abused and outraged the modesty of the petitioner as well as her daughters.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for her grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a complaint/representation dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur i.e. Respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, has put in appearance through the medium of video conferencing and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to take a decision on the representation dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
