[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 12.

[3] Learned counsel contends that petitioner No.1 had submitted representation dated 02.09.2021 (Annexure P-11) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of this petition but no decision has been taken on the same till date and in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-11 dated 02.09.2021 in accordance with law by taking into account all aspects of the matter.

objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

[7] Accordingly, in the light of statement of counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-11, dated 02.09.2021 in accordance with law, after taking into account all the aspects of the matter and further take action in respect thereto as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case, as expeditiously as possible.
