Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.110 dated 18.10.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 23.11.2020: -

*“...Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the real aunt (Bua) of the complainant and in order to explore the possibility of some settlement, she is ready to pay a sum of Rs.01 lac to the victim-complainant Jagjit Singh.*

*Counsel for the petitioner further submits that in fact, the*

*parties are also having a civil litigation regarding the land of Gurcharan Singh, the grand-father of the complainant and the father of petitioner-Gurpreet Kaur.*

*Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant are not averse to the same...”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.11.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
