The matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing in the light of Pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

Vide order dated 19.11.2020, this Court directed learned State counsel to get the instructions with regard to the status of the applications dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-6) and 12.10.2020 (Annexure P-8) which are pending adjudication.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for want of inspection report, he is unable to prefer appeal before the competent authority. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that though the final order has been passed but still as on today the petitioner has not been allowed to inspect the record.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 5 states that he has no objection in case the petitioner inspects the record.

In view of the fact that the final penalty order has been passed by the competent authority, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition.

However, we direct respondent No.4 to allow the petitioner to inspect the necessary record pertaining to his case file on any working day with prior intimation to the concerned officer. The petitioner shall inform the office of respondent No.4 three days prior to the proposed date of the inspection.
