Short reply by way of affidavit of Harjit Singh, PPS, DSP, Dhakha,
District Ludhiana on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is
taken on record.

The applicant is seeking interim bail on account of wedding of his
sister which was scheduled for 11.10.2021. It has been pointed out by the learned
counsel for the petitioner that some ceremonies are also likely to be performed
thereafter.

As per reply, the marriage has been solemnized on 11.10.2021.

There is nothing to suggest that subsequent to the marriage any other
ceremony is to be performed, wherein the presence of the applicant is necessary.

It has been argued by the learned counsel for the applicant that the
applicant is in custody since long and as such he may be granted interim bail so
