Case taken up through video conferencing.

This application is for placing on record power of attorney along with NOC on behalf of the petitioner.

Heard. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the power of attorney along with NOC is taken on record.

Main case

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.251 dated 20.09.2021 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506, 384 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of 15 days in lodging the FIR wherein it is alleged that the petitioner and other accused had beaten up the complainant and her daughter, vandalized their house, hurled abuses and threatened them. He, however, contends that the FIR

is the counterblast to the complaint made by co-accused Swati against the complainant, who is her mother-in-law. It is a case of no injury as there is no medico legal report. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over two months since his arrest on 20.09.2021.

Learned State counsel upon instructions states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far. He also contends that the petitioner is involved in two other cases.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for over two months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
