JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

These are two petitions that have been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.8 dated 22.08.2020 under Sections 406, 498-A and 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Women Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners herein would contend that the matter has been compromised. Even otherwise, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-complainant would submit that as per the term of compromise an amount of Rs.10 lakh has to be handed over by the petitioners to the complainant.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners would contend that in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties, an amount of Rs.10 lakh would be paid on the date the divorce is granted.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarlok Singh, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated and the custody is no longer required.

I have heard counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the petitioners herein have joined investigation and compromise is being given effect, the petition is allowed and orders dated 19.11.2020 22.12.2020, granting interim bail to the petitioners are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Needless to say, in case the compromise is not given effect to its entirety, the complainant would have remedy of getting revived these petitions.
