The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of detenue Harpreet Kaur from illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy, learned State Counsel had appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Mr. Praveen Sharma, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 and he undertakes to file his power of attorney in the Registry.

Reply by way of affidavit of Jaswinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Ghanour, District Patiala on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 was filed. In the reply it was mentioned that

detenue Harpreet Kaur was living with Satnam Singh in live-in-relationship with her own free will.

Detenue Harpreet Kaur is present before this Court through video conferencing for hearing of connected CRWP-9887-2020 and on being asked by the Court stated that she has now solemnized marriage with Satnam Singh out of her own free will on 22.12.2020 and is living with him out of her own free will.

In view of the above, no further proceedings are required to be taken in the present habeas corpus petition, which is disposed of accordingly.
