Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.67 dated 02.02.2019, registered under Sections 166, 218, 420, 447, 465, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 08.10.2021, whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating
