Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take necessary legal action against the private respondents No.4 to 6 on the basis of the complaint dated 26.08.2021, Annexure P-2, submitted by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who retired from the Indian Air Force was assaulted by his son in the presence of a co-villager, Ramchander. Counsel submits that the son of the petitioner was in an inebriated condition and wanted the petitioner to transfer the land in his favour. According to the counsel, the petitioner called the police help-line, who reached the spot, but no action was taken and a complaint dated 26.08.2021, Annexure P-2, was submitted to the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram-respondent No.2, which is still pending. Counsel submits that

the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the complaint, Annexure P-2.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the complaint, Annexure P-2, and to take suitable action as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the order as well as the complaint, Annexure P-2, be sent to the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram-respondent No.2 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
