The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-department to release the entire retrial benefits including the pension, of the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum, which has been withhold by the respondent-department, along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 07.09.2021 (Annexure P-2), within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondents are directed to take a conscious decision in the representation dated 07.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents-State, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
