GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.326 dated 05.06.2020 registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, under Sections 420/406 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 23.11.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Assandh, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioner Amrik Singh and also of complainant

Kushwant have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Kushwant in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned SDJM, Assandh has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion and undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.326 dated 05.06.2020 registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, under Sections 420/406 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
