This petition has been filed under the provisions of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 3 sub sections (1) (d) and Section 5-A of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoner (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 and Amended Act, 2015, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-State to grant parole or to take the petitioner under armed police escort to the Bank of Baroda, Shop No. 28, New Grain Market, Rohtak, to enable him to access and withdraw cash amount so that he can pay his counsel expenses, and hand over the remaining amount to his old aged parents for their livelihood and expenditure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the representation made to the Superintendent, District Jail, Rohtak (respondent no.4) in respect of his grievance.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the said respondent to take a decision on the aforesaid representation dated 02.07.2021 (copy Annexure P-1), within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

If the Superintendent is not competent to do so himself, he would forward the said representation immediately to the competent authority concerned, who would then pass an order within three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
