LISA GILL, J.

Admittedly, there is an alternate remedy of appeal available to the petitioner under the Haryana Registration & Regulation of Societies Act, 2012, for challenging impugned order dated 04.10.2021 (Annexure P-1). Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the present petitioner was not even put to notice before passing of the order as the Handball Federation of India was represented by a person not entitled to represent the Federation, therefore, present writ petition should be entertained.

Be that as it may, I do not find any extra ordinary ground to interfere in this matter in exercise of jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Therefore, this writ petition is dismissed. It is open to the petitioner to raise all the pleas, as available to it, before the Appellate Authority, in the appeal if any, which may be filed by the petitioner besides agitate for interim relief as is sought in this writ petition.
