Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.142 dated 23.09.2017, under Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 120-B IPC and Sections 4, 6 of POCSO Act, at Police Station Saha, District Ambala, Haryana.

It has been submitted that the petitioner is behind the bars since 17th September, 2019. On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that there are two prosecutrices in this case, one is 21 years of age and another is 16 years of age. He further submits that out of 21 prosecution witnesses, 16 witnesses have already been examined and now the case is fixed before the trial Court for examining rest of the witnesses.

In view of the submissions made above, I find that no ground is made out for grant of bail to the petitioner. However, learned trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest.

Petition is dismissed.
