Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 to 7 who forcefully trespassing into the petitioner's house and also to direct respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 18.07.2021 (Annexure P-7).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has filed representation dated 18.07.2021 (Annexure P-7) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, for the redressal of her

claim and he will be satisfied if the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, to look into the representation (Annexure P-7) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of one month from today.
