By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to respondents no.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation and to take appropriate action against the culprits in case bearing FIR no.119, dated 09.05.2019, registered at Police Station Women, Nuh, District Nuh (Mewat), alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 376, 511, 354-B, 323, 506, 120-B of the IPC read with Section 34 thereof.

A reply having been filed thereto by the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, learned State counsel points out therefrom that the investigation in the matter is complete and the report under Section 173(2) of the Cr.P.C. has already been submitted to the competent court, with two accused having been arrested and some

having been found to be innocent and with the allegations alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 376, 377 and 354 having been found to be without any basis.

Mr. Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that this petition may be disposed of with appropriate orders.

That being so, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but obviously with the petitioner at liberty to take an appropriate remedy before the competent court if she is aggrieved in any manner of the report submitted under the provisions of Section 173(2) of the Cr.P.C.
