The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in FIR No.224 dated 07.06.2021 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC (Section 3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 added later on) at Police Station Butana, District Karnal.

On 13.10.2021 this Court passed the following order: -

“Notice of motion.

Mr. Bhupender Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana to accept notice on behalf of the respondent. Let a copy of the Paper-book be supplied to him.

To come up along with CRM-M-34436-2021, which is already fixed on 17.11.2021.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail on the same terms as directed by the Co-ordinate Bench in the case of co-accused Vikash Ahlawat in the aforesaid CRM-M-34436-2021.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioners have joined investigation; have cooperated with the investigating agency and that their custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above and the statement made by learned State counsel that the petitioners' custodial interrogation is not required, the order of this Court dated 13.10.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
