The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0103 dated 03.05.2019, registered under Sections 379, 447, 34 of the IPC at Police Station Tigaon.

The operative part of the order dated 23.11.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was granted interim bail by the Court of Sessions but later on, the same was dismissed on 04.11.2020 as the petitioner could not join investigation, however, while passing the said order, co-accused Leele Ram @ Leelu was granted concession of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel further submits that petitioner is ready to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation.

Notice of motion for 24.02.2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 23.11.2020, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Prem Dutt, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 23.11.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
