The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0042 dated 08.04.2018, under Sections 324, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division 2, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the incident is the outcome of a sudden quarrel between the parties and the matter has been compromised. A copy of the compromise is at Annexure P2. The injuries are on the non-vital parts of the body of the injured.

This Court, by order dated 16.11.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 16.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
