The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C., seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents no. 2 and 3 to get released the alleged detainee, namely Kulwinder Singh son of Mehar Singh resident of Village and Post Office Jadot, Tehsil Derabassi, District SAS Nagar Mohali, from the illegal detention of respondent no. 4 (as alleged).

The matter having remained pending over a period of time with different orders passed by noticing that in fact appropriate legal proceedings had been taken against respondent no. 4 for running a de-addiction centre even after the validity of his license had expired (as per the respondent-State , which naturally would be seen in appropriate proceedings by the competent court), today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

detenue having been released from custody and appropriate proceedings having been initiated against respondent no. 4, he does not press this petition.

That being so, this petition is dismissed as not pressed any further.

Learned counsel for respondent no. 4 however wishes to draw attention to the statement made by the alleged detenue, before the JMIC, Dera Bassi, on 12.12.2020, to the effect that he was never kept in illegal detention.

Naturally, if that issue comes in any proceedings against respondent no. 4, he would be at liberty to take such defence if such defence is admissible, as per law.
