The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the pension and other retiral benefits to the petitioner alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, for which, representation dated 08.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) has also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representation dated 08.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by

passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
