By this petition, the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR No.205, dated 18.09.2021, having been registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 323/324/506 and 452 of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 12.10.2021, the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, dated 01.12.2021, has been received, stating to the effect that the petitioners and the complainant-Jagtar Singh (respondent No.2) appeared before that court and stated that the matter has been compromised between them voluntarily.

As per the statement of the investigating officer before that court, none of the petitioners has been declared to be a proclaimed

offendor.

Though one of the accused, Gurpreet Singh, did not come present before that court, he is obviously not a petitioner in this petition and this being a petition seeking that the petitioners be admitted to anticipatory bail, his not being present before the Judicial Magistrate would make no difference to the matter.

As per the assessment of that court, the compromise arrived at between the parties is indeed voluntary.

That being so, without making any comment on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the order dated 12.10.2021 made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.
