LISA GILL, J.

Petitioners seek benefit of notional pay fixation with effect from the date of initial joining of the first set of candidates to the post of primary teacher as has been allegedly done qua several similarly situated candidates when other persons were recruited as Primary Teachers in the same Batch as the petitioners. Petitioner also seeks release of arrears of pay after re-fixation of their pay from the date when they actually joined. It is further submitted that despite submitting legal notice dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P7) upon the respondents, no action is being taken.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts the prayer for a decision on legal notice dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P7), submitted by the petitioners, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Advance copy of writ petition stands supplied. Learned counsel for the respondent-State does not raise serious objection to the restricted prayer.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances

of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide legal notice dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P7), if any, by passing a speaking order, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
