The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is fourth petition for grant of bail pending trial arising from case FIR No.298, dated 17.09.2017, under Section 147, 148, 149, 506, 307 of IPC and Section 25, 54 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, Sector 31, Chandigarh.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner has a criminal past and he already stands convicted in FIR No.82, dated 23.04.2010, under Section 323, 325, 506 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

Furthermore, the petitioner is facing prosecution in as many as four criminal cases including a case involving offence of dacoity.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no fresh ground to grant concession of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
