The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No. 17 dated 15.10.2020, under Sections 326, 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) in FIR No. 263 dated 14.10.2020, under Sections 452, 427, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Ghumaan, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of version and cross-version. The petitioners have been attributed simple injuries.

This Court, by order dated 11.10.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Darshan Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 11.10.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
