The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Lecturer from the date prior to her date of retirement and commute her pension accordingly alongwith all consequential benefits and damages, for which, legal notice dated 18.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner,

the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 18.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
