The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.521 dated 07.11.2020 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 120-B IPC and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

Notice of motion was issued on 23.11.2020 and thereafter the petitioners were directed to join the investigation on 20.12.2020 vide order dated 15.12.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in

compliance of the aforesaid order dated 15.12.2020, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Suresh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation of the case.
