By this petition filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail, upon FIR no.0431, dated 08.08.2021, having been registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 148/149/302/324 of the IPC.

Though the petitioner is stated to have been in custody for more than 3 years, looking at the fact that he is the prime accused who allegedly killed the deceased with a pair of scissors and 12 prosecution witnesses out of 23 have already been examined, I am not inclined to admit him to bail.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed.

Naturally, the trial court would make an earnest endeavour to

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conclude the trial at the earliest.
