1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 29.01.2021 in LPA No.897 of 2020, staying the operation of the order, violation of which has been complained of in the instant petition, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to file an application for revival of the contempt petition in case of vacation of stay or decision of LPA No. 897 of 2020 in his favour, whichever is earlier.
4. The same is not opposed by the learned DAG, Haryana.
5. In view of the position as noted above, I am of the view that no action is required to be taken on the Contempt Petition at this stage. Accordingly, Rule is discharged and the Contempt Petition is permitted to be withdrawn at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the Contempt Petition in the eventuality of stay granted in LPA

No. 897 of 2020 being vacated or the aforementioned LPA being decided in
favour of the petitioner, whichever is earlier.
